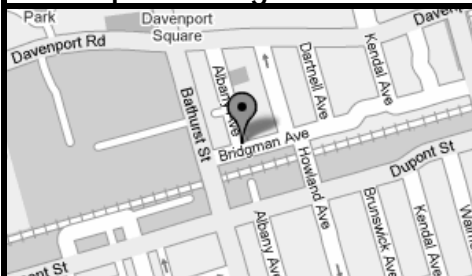

History and fun are integrated in this imaginative retelling of the classic fairy tale. *Puppetmongers* reset the story in 1834, just as "Muddy" York is to be renamed Toronto, where Ella is expected to cater to every whim of her just-off-the-boat-from-England stepmother and sisters. With a little magic and some imaginative special effects she does get herself to the Ball, and to the satisfying conclusion of the tale. The play is ingeniously staged with a traditional marionette theatre that transforms, as the story unfolds, into scenes evoking the wilderness, pioneer life and early Canadian society. **Recommended for JK to Grade 6.**
